December 2017 Graduating Students Survey - Undergraduates

In December 2017, the Institutional Research office surveyed 204 graduating students. Of the 204 students we surveyed, we received 125 responses for a 61.3% response rate.

The workbook tabs contain the following information collected in the survey:

Undergraduate Attitudes: The survey contained seven statements the students ranked on a five-point scale.

Primary Activity & Employment: Students were asked to select their primary goal following graduation. Options included: working full or part-time, going to graduate school, volunteering, and joining the military. Students who selected full or part-time employment as their goal were asked to list the name of their employer and their starting annual base salary.

Career Services: Students were asked which of a list of available career services they made use of while at UMHB.
