- Did you know that one time in 1886, there was an emergency meeting of the board of trustees to decide if a graduation dress color was appropriate?
- Did you know that as early as 1887, Mary Hardin-Baylor was offering courses in bookkeeping so women could earn a livelihood?
- Did you know that a rule prohibited students in the early 1900s from doing other people's laundry?
- Did you know that a trip to see President McKinley speak in Austin in 1901 helped students decide to add purple to our school colors?
- Did you know Stunt Night started because the university president felt sorry for the girls who couldn't go home for the holidays?
- Did you know the first year a student had a car on campus was 1922?
- Did you know that college enrollment declined during WWII, and empty dorms and halls were rented out to military families?
- Did you know that in the early days of Mary Hardin-Baylor, freshmen were identified by their green and white caps that they were required to wear? Before caps, they wore green and white in their outfits to show they were freshmen?
