# Did you know?

- Many girls stayed on campus over the holidays, to combat homesickness, a long-standing tradition was started in 1909, "Stunt Night!"
- There was often a campus-wide Christmas dinner for which one of the professors would dress as Santa, passing out small gifts to students who remained on campus for the holidays.
- Student's trips to town to do Christmas shopping had to be approved by the administration.
- In the 1990s, UMHB used to put on a Christmas Nativity show in December for the Belton community.
- For more than 70 years, UMHB has provided a Christmas dinner for faculty, staff, and their families.



## Peanut Butter Balls Recipe

### **Ingredients:**

- 11/2 cup of Peanut Butter
- 1 cup of Softened Butter
- 1 tsp Vanilla
- 6 cups of Confectioners Sugar
- 4 cups of Semi Sweet Chocolate Chips

#### How to make:

- 1. In a large bowl, mix together peanut butter, butter, vanilla, and confectioner sugar. Dough will look dry, Roll into 1 inch balls and place on waxed paper lined cookie sheet.
- 2. Press a toothpick into the top of each ball, to be used later for dipping. Chill in freezer for 30 minutes.
- 3. Melt chocolate chips in a double broiler, stir until smooth.
- 4. Holding onto the toothpick, dip frozen peanut butter balls in chocolate, place back on cookie sheet, and refrigerate until serving.



### Alma Mater Ornament

#### Materials:

- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Hot glue gun and clear glue sticks
- Gold ribbon, cut to 12" long
- 1 tbsp coffee \*optional
- Paintbrush \*optional

#### Directions:

- 1. Using a paintbrush and quick strokes, brush coffee across the music sheet to give an aged look. \*optional
- 2. Cut out the six circles.
- 3. Fold each circle shapes in half.
- 4. Stack three folded circles on top of each other, gluing the sides together. Stack another three folded circles in the same way and glue together.
- 5. Using a hot glue gun, glue the ends of the ornament cap to the top of one 3D half circle.
- 6. Glue the half circle together sandwiching the cap ends in between to form a finished 3D ornament. And lastly, loop the ribbon through the cap ring knotting the ends to form a loop for hanging.
